

# FIRST UNITED METHODIST CHURCH, KALAMAZOO, MI DAVID H ROHS YOUTH FUND SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES & APPLICATION FORM

- **1)** Offer up to \$1,000 scholarships to interested youth/young adults who are active participants at FUMC, and plan to attend a **United Methodist-related** college, university or seminary in the U.S. for any course of study towards an undergraduate/seminary/graduate/professional studies degree, **OR #2 or #3 below.**
  - NOTE: Scholarship honoree above then has the option to *apply* for United Methodist Higher Education Foundation “Quadruple Dollars for Scholars” funds whereby “qualified applicants who receive \$1,000 from a United Methodist church may receive up to \$3,000 in additional funding (i.e., a maximum of \$4,000 per academic year) toward their undergraduate or seminary education” at a **United Methodist-related** college, university, or seminary.
- **2)** Offer up to \$1,000 scholarships to interested youth/young adults who are active participants at FUMC, and plan to attend a **NON-Methodist-related** college, university or seminary in the U.S. These scholarships cannot receive matching funds from the United Methodist Foundation.
- **3)** Offer \$500 scholarships to interested youth/young adults who are active participants at FUMC, and plan to pursue a course of study at a **NON-Methodist-related** community college/trades school in the U.S. These scholarships cannot receive matching funds from United Methodist Foundation.
- The Youth Pastor and two Trustees to be involved in the application review process, with final approval by the FUMC Board of Trustees. Scholarship renewal can be considered; however, a new application is required.

• The scholarships may be used for tuition and fees, room and board, books, transportation and personal expenses associated with the cost of education.

Application period begins January 1, 2019 and deadline for submission is March 29, 2019. Scholarship renewal can be considered the following year; however, a new application is required.
